Event Description

In today's technology-oriented economy the importance of STEM training, skills and experience is becoming increasingly evident. Employers in all industries are experiencing significantly increased demand for workers with training in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) in fields across-the-board. And these workers are becoming ever more difficult to find, which adversely affects the ability for Michigan, and the U.S. to achieve economic growth goals.

To help insure Michigan is taking a leadership position in generating STEM talent, the SE Michigan STEM Alliance, the Michigan STEM Partnership, and the Mobile Technology Association of Michigan (MTAM) are partnering to produce the SE Michigan Regional STEM Summit, a 2-day event with planned attendance of 500+. This event is designed to serve as a means of:

- Increasing student/career-changer awareness of STEM careers diversity
- Increasing parent awareness of same in order to increase parents encouragement of STEM careers; particularly for female & minority students
- Providing educators with curriculum resources to meet the workforce needs of the business community
- Providing awareness and understanding of high-need STEM Career Pathways in SE Michigan for students and parents
- Generating a common understanding and culture of STEM
- Providing Michigan firms an opportunity to showcase themselves and their STEM-related products/services, while increasing awareness among students, career-changers, parents, educators and legislators about their employment needs – now and in the future
- Providing current students an opportunity to showcase their work in STEM
- Providing businesses the opportunity to recruit STEM Interns/Employees at a STEM-focused Job Fair
- Helping legislators gain a comprehensive understanding of the complete STEM infrastructure, the high-demand for a STEM workforce and the resources needed to make Michigan a national leader in STEM initiatives and talent availability










Why STEM is Important




By 2020, there will be 1.4 million computer specialist job openings expected to go unfilled; in Michigan, we expect to see over 100,000 of these job openings – again, by 2020. We currently have 14,289 open computing jobs in Michigan (4x the average demand in the state).

These jobs are critical to our automotive, healthcare, general manufacturing, defense and other industries in the state.










STEM Jobs - Projections by Field



Middle-skill positions — which require posthigh school education, but not necessarily a 4-year degree, are expected to feature the highest number of job postings — particularly in Computing-related careers.






Fastest Growing STEM IT Careers


- 2/3 of IT jobs are posted by employers in industries such as healthcare, mftg and banking with the remaining 1/3 in IT and tech services
- 75% of open IT jobs are in the middle or entry-level
- Detroit is among Top 10 cities with greatest demand for IT jobs


 For every 8 IT jobs in the Top 10 demand cities, the current talent pool only yields 5 workers





Gender Gap in STEM






